**IAC GIRLS BOWLING: LADY WOLVERINES RUN WIN STREAK TO 24**

ELMIRA — Ariana Deming, Nicole Rice and Danielle LaRue all shot 600 series as the Lady Wolverines rolled a season-high team score en route to a 4-0 sweep of Edison in IAC girls bowling action here Thursday afternoon.

The sweep — their sixth straight to open the season — also runs the Lady Wolverines' win streak to 24 games this season.

Waverly blasted out a 999 in the first game, easily outdistancing Edison's 761, then won the second game 953-747 and the final game by a slimmer margin of 900-832. Waverly had a 512-pin edge in total pinfall — 2,852 to 2,340.

Deming fired games of 235 and 258 before cooling down a bit with a 170 for a 663, which is a team-high for the season. Rice wasn't much behind, rolling a team-high 243 for the season in the first game and following it up with a 192 and a 214 for a 649 series.

Danielle LaRue had games of 215 and 233 before rolling a 168 in the final game for a 616 series.

Katelyn Moore added a 489 series and Nicole Fuller chipped in with a 435.

Christy Wise led Edison with a 586 series and Amanda Menechella added a 553.

Waverly is back in action Tuesday at the Valley Bowling Center when it hosts Elmira Notre Dame.
